Harbor Operations Supervisor/ Travelift Operator

POSITION SUMMARY: The Operations and Maintenance Supervisor ensures a clean, functional, and safe working environment for Harbor and Port operations by overseeing moorage, facility

maintenance, and security. Responsible for direct supervision of two year-round full-time Harbor Maintenance I personnel. In the absence of the Harbormaster, may temporarily assume full responsibility for duties of the Harbormaster.

QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of a GED. One (1) year supervisory experience. One (1) year facility maintenance experience, preferably harbor maintenance. Valid State of Alaska driver's license and the ability to obtain a Class B Commercial Driver's License within six (6) months of hire. Ability to obtain Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC). Preference given to candidates with experience in harbor/port operations, small engine repair and maintenance and/or HazMat or First Aid certification.
